Technical Information

1.VD53 Quartz Movement

- 1) Pull out the crown to the first click to amend the date.
- 2) Turn the crown clockwise until the correct day's date appears.
- 3) Pull out the crown to the second click to adjust the time, this will cause the time to stop to allow you to adjust it. Set the hands to the desired time of the day (make sure AM/PM is set correctly) by turning the crown clockwise.

*When the crown is at the second click position. Do not press any button, otherwise the chronograph hands will move.

- 4) Push the crown back into the normal position once you have set the time and / or date
- 5) To use the stopwatch function, click the top button in and hold for 2-3 seconds and the stopwatch [middle dial] will start.
- 6) If you need to stop the stopwatch, hold the top button in again, and repeat as required to stop/start the stopwatch.
- 7) If you wish to reset the stopwatch, hold the bottom button down for 2-3 seconds and the stopwatch will return to the start, please note it will return to 3 seconds prior to 0 to account for start / finish of the stopwatch

2.Waterproof performance

The water resistance of the Stonebridge collection watches is up to 5ATM (50 Metres). That means you can wear our watches while washing hands with cold water or having a walk on a rainy day. That doesn't mean you can wear it while taking bath or swimming (details check the "Precautions" section), this will cause the watch to stop working and will invalidate any warranty. 5ATM relates to water pressure and is not related to water depth.

Precautions

Correct use of the Stonebridge collection will ensure long-term normal operation and precise timing.

Temperature

Do not expose your watch to the environment with drastic changes in temperature (immediately immersed in cold water after in isolation) or extreme temperature (above 60 degree or below 0 degree).

Shock

Avoid thermal shock and other shocks that may damage your watch.

Hazardous products

Avoid direct contact with solvents, detergents, perfumes, cosmetics, etc. Which may damage bracelet, case or washer.

Cleaning

We recommend that your watch be cleaned regularly with a soft cloth to prevent sweat-induced corrosion. All waterproof watches can be cleaned with a toothbrush and clean water and then wipe it dry with a soft cloth.

Warranty

All watches purchased direct from Terence Clack Watches with proof of purchase are eligible for a one year manufacturers warranty. This does not cover negligence or misuse.
